Legislative Committee

January 5, 2023

To all members of the Legislative Committee, there were no new bills introduced since the last report. The total number of bills stay the same at 8,763 for this session. There was one new bill added to our tracking lists this week, S-871, allows municipalities to conduct annual event for open burning of Christmas trees, was added to Fire & Emergency Services. This bill is not a new bill it was introduced on 01/18/2022, however there was some concerns about this bill due to the holidays that recently passed with this bill possibly having some action. This bill was introduced and only referred to the Senate Environment and Energy Committee, but it has not been heard or moved from there at this time. The total number of our tracked bills are now at 139, with 98 bills in Fire & Emergency Services and 41 bills in Pensions. There are currently eighteen bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has signed 148 bills to date.

There will be a Voting Session for the Senate on Tuesday January 10, 2023 (they have not posted a bill list as of this report). There will be an Assembly Quorum on Tuesday, January 10, 2023, and an Assembly & Senate Quorum on Thursday, January 12, 2023. They have not posted which committees will meet on these days nor have they posted a bill list as of this report.
