Legislative Committee

January 26, 2023

To all members of the Legislative Committee, there were 67 new bills introduced since the last report. The total number of bills are at 8,921 for this session. I added one new bill to our tracking lists this week, SCR133, proposes constitutional amendment authorizing municipalities to provide partial property tax exemption to certain first responders disabled as result of World Trade Center recovery medical condition. This bill is a related bill to one that we already track, ACR170. Both bills were introduced last month and were referred to committee hearings but have not moved from there. The total number of our tracked bills is now at 143, with 101 bills in Fire & Emergency Services and 42 bills in Pensions. There are currently eleven bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has signed 154 bills to date.

There are Senate Committee Meetings for today as well as an Assembly Voting Session for this afternoon, but none of our tracked bills are listed for today. There will be Senate Committee Meetings for Monday, January 30, 2023, but none of our tracked bills are listed on any of those meetings. There is a Senate Voting Session on the schedule for Thursday, February 2, 2023, at 2:00 pm but they have not posted the list of bills yet for that session.
