Legislative Committee February 23, 2023

To all members of the Legislative Committee, there were 53 new bills introduced since the last report. The total number of bills are at 9,174 for this session. No new bills were added to our tracking lists this week. The total number of our tracked bills stayed the same at 149, with 107 bills in Fire & Emergency Services and 42 bills in Pensions. There are currently twelve bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has signed 166 bills to date.

There are Senate and Assembly Committee Meetings for today, with none of our tracked bills listed to be heard in any of them. There are Senate and Assembly Voting Sessions for Monday, February 27, 2023, but none of our tracked bills are listed to be voted on for these sessions. As soon as they finalize both schedules for next month, I will forward them to everyone.

Last week, at the Assembly Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, A-2835, allows person on police officer or firefighter eligible list who is unable to complete requirements for employment due to certain military service to have name placed on subsequent eligible list was released by committee.
