Legislative Committee

April 13, 2023

To all members of the Legislative Committee, there have been no new bills introduced since the last report. The total number of bills stayed the same at 9,530 for this session. The total number of our tracked bills is now 160, with 115 bills in Fire & Emergency Services and 45 bills in Pensions. There are currently thirty-eight bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has signed 188 bills to date. The Governor signed a few bills so far for this month. Not anything that we have been tracking but just in case anyone is curious this is one of the bills signed recently. S-2866, establishes "Elections Transparency Act;" requires independent expenditure committees report campaign contributions exceeding \$1000; increases contribution limits; changes reporting and other requirements; concerns certain business entity contributions and certain local provisions.

There are no committee meetings on the schedule for this week. Then the rest of the month there are only Senate and Assembly Budget Committee Meetings listed.

I have not set a date for the annual Legislative meeting. I am looking at a weeknight in the middle of May and the meeting will be held virtually via zoom. Once I finalize the date, I will confirm with everyone and set it up.
