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Legislative Committee October 13, 2022

To all members of the Legislative Committee, there were 50 new bills introduced since last week. The total number of bills are at 8,334 for this new session. I added nine new bills to our tracking lists. I attached them all, 3 were related bills to ones we are already tracking, 4 were bills converted from last Legislative Session, and two were new ones added. I did some housekeeping since last report and added these bills to our lists. The total number of our tracked bills are now at 129, with 89 bills in Fire & Emergency Services and 40 bills in Pensions. There are currently two bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has signed 121 bills to date.

I attached a calendar report for today which has two of our tracked bills listed in committee meetings. I also attached a calendar report for Monday, October 17, 2022, which has one of our bills listed for a voting session for the Senate at 2:00 pm.
