## **Legislative Committee October 20, 2022**

To all members of the Legislative Committee, there were 96 new bills introduced since last week. The total number of bills are at 8,334 for this new session. I added three new bills to our tracking lists this week. I attached them all; 2 were related bills (S-2881 & S-3188) to ones we are already tracking, and one is a new bill (S-3237) that appropriates the funds for the Training of Firefighters for electric vehicles. The total number of our tracked bills are now at 132, with 91 bills in Fire & Emergency Services and 41 bills in Pensions. There are currently seven bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has signed 122 bills to date.

I attached a calendar report for today, however, none of our tracked bills are listed in committee meetings. The Senate Voting Session for Monday, October 24, 2022, has been canceled. I also attached a calendar report for Thursday, October 27, 2022, there is an Assembly Voting Session and Senate Committee Meetings, but they have not posted a bill list yet as of this report.
