Legislative Committee October 27, 2022

To all members of the Legislative Committee, there were 14 new bills introduced since last week. The total number of bills are at 8,334 for this new session. The total number of our tracked bills stayed the same at 132, with 91 bills in Fire & Emergency Services and 41 bills in Pensions. There are currently four bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has signed 125 bills to date.

One of our tracked bills was signed into law this past week, A-4107, makes various changes concerning regulation of emergency medical services; establishes mobile integrated health program and new State Emergency Medical Services Director in DOH.

I attached a calendar report for today, showing three of our tracked bills listed for a voting session in the Assembly. There is a Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee Meeting on Monday, October 31, 2022, they have not posted a bill list yet as of this report. There is also a Senate Quorum set for Thursday, November 3, 2022, however, they have not posted a list of committee meetings and the bills list as of this report. I am also including a revised Assembly Schedule for the remainder of the year.
