Legislative Committee November 17, 2022

To all members of the Legislative Committee, there were 44 new bills introduced since the last report. The total number of bills are at 8,455 for this session. The total number of our tracked bills stayed the same at 135, with 94 bills in Fire & Emergency Services and 41 bills in Pensions. There are currently eight bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has signed 130 bills to date.

I attached a copy of my Legislative Report for the Executive Committee meeting for Saturday, November 19, 2022. If anyone has any questions, please let me know. Just to note that report, we have been meeting with members of the Senate and Assembly to draft new legislation for Cancer Screenings for Volunteer Firefighters with and without the State Health Benefits Plan. To hopefully mimic the two bills that were signed into law for cancer screenings for Career Firefighters with and without the State Health Benefits Plan.

There are Senate and Assembly Voting Sessions scheduled for Monday, November 21, 2022. One of our tracked bills, A-2886 is listed to be voted on by the Assembly (see attached). If anyone has any questions, please let me know.
