Legislative Committee **January 25, 2024**

To all members of the Legislative Committee, as we enter the 221st Legislative Session, 2024-2025, I have converted all the previous tracked bills into our new Tracking Lists consisting of the bills that were automatically renewed to date (see attached). Our three tracking lists will now be Fire & Emergency Services, Firemen's Home, and Pensions. The bills that are in the new tracking list, Firemen's Home, are all renewed bills from last year's tracking list that I created. I still need to go through some of these bills as some of them are generic bills.

The total number of bills introduced as of today are at 5,945 already for this session. Out of that number only 43 bills are brand new bills for this legislative session. I went through these 43 bills and none of them were added to our tracking lists. The total number of our tracked bills is at 164, with 81 bills in Fire & Emergency Services, 51 bills in Firemen's Home, and 32 bills in Pensions. There are currently no bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has not signed any bills to date.

There were some Senate Committee Meetings on the schedule for today. There are some Assembly and Senate Committee Meetings on the schedule for next week on Monday, January 29, 2024. However, none of our tracked bills are list to be heard for either one of those days. I attached the copy of the Assembly Schedule from now till mid-March. They haven't posted the schedule for the Senate yet for the upcoming months. I also attached a copy of the list of committees with the new assignments for both the Assembly and Senate members.
