

Legislative Committee **March 7, 2024**

To all members of the Legislative Committee, the total number of bills introduced is 7,395 already for this session. There were 105 bills added since the last report. I added 7 new bills to our tracking lists this week (see attached). The total number of our tracked bills changed and is now at 217, with 114 bills in Fire & Emergency Services, 65 bills in Firemen's Home, and 38 bills in Pensions. The bills added were converted bills from last year's session that was just recently added and one bill that was a related bill that we are already tracking. There are currently no bills sitting on The Governor's Desk and he has not signed any bills to date.

There are Assembly and Senate Quorums on the schedule for Monday, March 11, 2024, with some committee meetings listed (see attached). There are two of our tracked bills listed to be heard during these meetings, S-2435 & A-2100. There is also Assembly and Senate Quorums on the schedule for next Thursday, March 14, 2024, however, they have not shared the list of committees or bills that will be heard.
