Legislative Committee

June 6, 2024

To all members of the Legislative Committee, the total number of bills introduced is 8,453 already for this session. There were 89 new bills added since the last report. The total number of our tracked bills stayed the same at 243, with 134 bills in Fire & Emergency Services, 71 bills in Firemen's Home, and 42 bills in Pensions. There is currently one bill sitting on The Governor's Desk waiting to be signed. The Governor signed seventeen bills into law to date including the new OPRA bill and one of our tracked bills, A-3939, mandates access to periodic cancer screening examinations for career firefighters not enrolled in SHBP, but who are eligible for SHBP by virtue of public employment.

On Monday, June 3, 2024, A-3532, provides gross income tax credit to active members of volunteer emergency service organizations for use of personal motor vehicle in performance of active duty, was heard in the Assembly Public Safety and Preparedness Committee and was reported out of committee and referred to the Assembly Appropriations Committee (we showed support for this bill in Trenton during the committee meeting).

There are some Assembly and Senate Committee Meetings on the schedule for today (see attached). A-3894, amends certain fire safety statutes to update licensure and equipment requirements and liability, fee, and penalty provisions, is listed in the Assembly State and Local Government Committee this afternoon. On Monday, June 10, 2024, there are some Assembly and Senate Committee Meetings on the schedule, however, none of our tracked bills are on the lists to be heard.

Please try to submit your votes for the bill voting list that I sent out. I have received some back already and I did mail out the paper copies to the ones that requested it. If anyone has any questions on any of the bills or needs any help with this, please don't hesitate to contact me.
