Legislative Committee

August 1, 2024

To all members of the Legislative Committee, the total number of bills introduced is 8,868 already for this session. There were no new bills added since the last report. The total number of our tracked bills stayed the same at 262, with 147 bills in Fire & Emergency Services, 71 bills in Firemen's Home, and 48 bills in Pensions. There are currently 35 bills sitting on The Governor's Desk waiting to be signed (one of our tracked bills is still sitting on his desk, see attached). The Governor signed fifty -one bills into law to date.

There is nothing on the schedule for this month as they are officially on their summer break.

I sent the convention worker information out to the committee. Please make sure you respond to that email so I can confirm that you know which day you're assigned.

I have completed the results for the Bill Voting List that was sent out from our annual meeting. The results are as a committee we are supporting all the bills except for two of them that had a few votes in the opposition or to take no action. I am placing both of these bills as us as a committee taking no action on them (A-1081/S-2776, Establishes certain marine firefighting training course requirements & S-2577, Authorizes fire districts to issue certain bond anticipation notes for up to 10 years following initial note issuance). I included a complete list of our bills as a progress report broken down into our three tracking lists showing the bills with the most action first. The lists shows all the positions of our bills with the updated results from the Bills Voting List.
