Legislative Committee October 3, 2024

To all members of the Legislative Committee, the total number of bills introduced is 9,274 already for this session. There were 149 new bills added since the last report, I added four new bills to our tracking lists (see attached). The total number of our tracked bills is now at 275, with 150 bills in Fire & Emergency Services, 73 bills in Firemen's Home, and 52 bills in Pensions. There are currently eleven bills sitting on The Governor's Desk waiting to be signed. The Governor signed eighty-one bills into law to date.

On Monday, September 30, 2024, two of our tracked bills were heard in the Senate Community and Urban Affairs Committee. S-1388, which permits inclusion of volunteer firefighters and other emergency responders within municipal eligible employee group for purposes of the small employer health benefits plan statutes, was reported out of committee, and referred to the Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee. S-3121, which requires certain local authorities to inspect, maintain, and repair fire hydrants in planned real estate developments, was reported out of committee with amendments, and was referred to the Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee.

There is nothing on the schedule for today there is a Senate Quorum for both Monday, October 7, 2024, and Thursday, October 10, 2024. They have not posted a list of committee hearings for either of these days yet.
