Legislative Committee October 10, 2024

To all members of the Legislative Committee, the total number of bills introduced is 9,303 already for this session. There were 29 new bills added since the last report. The total number of our tracked bills stayed the same at 275, with 150 bills in Fire & Emergency Services, 73 bills in Firemen's Home, and 52 bills in Pensions. There are currently nine bills sitting on The Governor's Desk waiting to be signed. The Governor signed eighty-three bills into law to date.

On Monday, October 7, 2024, one of our tracked bills was heard in the Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee. S-2580, which amends certain fire safety statutes to update licensure and equipment requirements and liability, fee, and penalty provisions; expands membership of Fire Protection Equipment Advisory Committee, was reported out of committee with committee amendments and is set for a second reading in Senate.

There are a bunch of Senate Committee Meetings on the schedule for today, however, none of our tracked bills are listed to be heard. On Thursday, October 17, 2024, there will be an Assembly Quorum but, they have not posted a list of committee hearings yet.
