## Legislative Committee February 6, 2025

To all members of the Legislative Committee, the total number of bills introduced is 10,072 already for this session. There were 106 new bills added since the last report. I added one new bill into our tracking list, Fire & Emergency Services, S-4132, which creates offense of impersonating first responder: grades offense one degree higher than underlying offense. The total number of our tracked bills is now at 299, with 168 bills in Fire & Emergency Services, 73 bills in Firemen's Home, and 58 bills in Pensions. There are currently fourteen bills sitting on The Governor's Desk waiting to be signed. The Governor signed one hundred thirty-six bills into law to date. One of our tracked bills was signed by the Governor this past week, A-3894, Amends certain fire safety statutes to update licensure and equipment requirements and liability, fee, and penalty provisions; expands membership of Fire Protection Equipment Advisory Committee.

On Monday, February 10, 2025, one of our tracked bills is listed to be heard in the Senate Higher Education Committee, S-2385, Increases tuition credit amount permitted under volunteer tuition credit program. I also attached the list of our tracked bills that were heard last week all four bills were reported out of the committees and referred to other committees for the second readings.
