Legislative Committee

June 5, 2025

To all members of the Legislative Committee, the total number of bills introduced is 11,037 already for this session. There were 56 new bills added since the last report. I added 4 new bills to our tracking lists (see attached). The total number of our tracked bills is now at 328, with 193 bills in Fire & Emergency Services, 74 bills in Firemen's Home, and 61 bills in Pensions. There are currently fifteen bills sitting on the Governor's Desk waiting to be signed. The Governor signed one hundred eighty-five bills into law to date.

There are Senate Committee Meetings on the schedule for today. However, none of our tracked bills are listed to be heard. On Monday, June 9, 2025, there is a Senate Health, Human Services and Senior Citizens Committee on the schedule and two of the Firemen's Home Tracked bills are listed to be heard (see attached).

Next Thursday, June 12, 2025, there is an Assembly and Senate Quorum on the schedule. They have not put out a list of committee meetings or a list of bills to be heard.

I received all the Bill Voting Lists back except for three of them. I will compile a list of the results for each bill and will send it out to everyone next week. I thank all of you for the responses as I still believe this is the easiest way to accomplish this task.
